	Part of an ocean or sea extending into the land (bigger than a bay).
	Place where sections of the earth's crust move relative to each other.
	Long narrow bank of sand.
	Large landmass that rises notably above its surroundings (larger than a hill).
	Stretch of muddy land that is exposed at low tide.
	Area of low wet land usually with lots of grasses.
	Large point of land extending into the water, usually at an abrupt angle.
	Shallow body of water protected from the sea by sandbars or reefs.
	Long narrow inlet of the sea between high cliffs.
	Flat area of sediment deposited at the mouth of a river.
	Small sheltered indentation in the shoreline.

Hill	Usually rounded elevation of land (lower than a mountain).
Cave	Large underground chamber.
Peak	Very top of a mountain ending in a point.
Oasis	Fertile area with water in the middle of a desert.
Stream	Small, narrow river.
Iceberg	Large floating mass of ice.
Pond	Small body of water.
Gulf	Part of an ocean or sea extending into the land (bigger than a bay).
Fault	Place where sections of the earth's crust move relative to each other.
Sandbar	Long narrow bank of sand.
Mountain	Large landmass that rises notably above its surroundings (larger than a hill).
Mud Flat	Stretch of muddy land that is exposed at low tide.
Marsh	Area of low wet land usually with lots of grasses.
Cape	Large point of land extending into the water, usually at an abrupt angle.
Lagoon	Shallow body of water protected from the sea by sandbars or reefs.
Fjord	Long narrow inlet of the sea between high cliffs.
Delta	Flat area of sediment deposited at the mouth of a river.
Cove	Small sheltered indentation in the shoreline.
